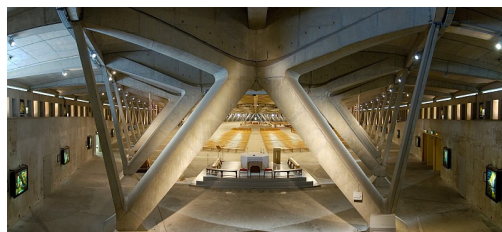

2. Underground Basilica

The Basilica of St Pius , known as the Underground Basilica, is the largest and most controversial of the Domain's churches. A modern concrete building, it is almost entirely underground and when full it can accommodate 25,000.

3. Abbey of St Savin (12th Century)
